>> The above chart shows which school district a non-Alabaster resident will attend each year, given their grade that year.

>> The chart is arranged so that a particular student's case will all be on the same line, and you can just read across to see when that student will go to a Shelby Co. school (and thus no longer be able to attend the Alabaster School System).

>> If a student's grade (for a particular year) is not shown on the chart, then that student will not be able to attend Alabaster schools that year (i.e., they will be attending a Shelby Co. school) -- Example is: Student that enters 2nd Grade in (Fall of) 2016.

For example: a student entering the 2nd Grade in 2013 will attend 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grades in Alabaster schools, and then transfer to Shelby Co. schools beginning with the 6th Grade.

Some conclusions based on above chart (which is result of Alabaster School Board's transition schedule):

- 1) No changes for 2013 (school year starting in Fall 2013)
- 2) All Students in 6th Grade (or above) in 2013 will be able to continue (and graduate) in Alabaster schools.
- 3) Students in K thru 5 (in Fall of 2013) would continue in Alabaster schools through 5th Grade, then go to Shelby Co. in 6th Grade.
- 4) Any student not yet starting kindergarden in 2013, or not yet starting 1st Grade in 2014, will always be going to Shelby Co. schools.
- 5) Once a (non-resident) student transfers to Shelby schools (per above chart), then they continue in Shelby schools through grade 12

Also, this schedule assumes that the student progresses 1 grade a year (i.e., is not held-back and is not double-promoted). It is unclear how these exception cases would be handled.
